NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR
LIVESTOCK FEEDLOT PERMIT**

Notice is hereby given per Minnesota Statutes 116.07, subd. 7(a), that Christine Koch, will be applying to Houston County and the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency for a permit to expand to 700 animal units of Holstein cattle. The proposed feedlot will be located in the Pt SW 1/4, NW 1/4 and Pt NW 1/4, SW 1/4, of Section 18 of Winnebago Township 101, Range 5 of Houston County, Minnesota. The feedlot will consist of: #1: Existing 54'x380' heifer barn with 3x20,000 gallons of manure storage, #2: Existing 54'x96' dry cows, #3: Existing 20'x40' calf barn, #4: Existing 40'x70' dry cows, #5: Proposed 42'x88' dry cows, #6: Existing 30'x80' calf barn, #7: Proposed 32'x240' calf barn, and 250 existing calf huts. The final animal unit capacity will be 700 animal units of Holsteins after the construction. The feedlot is owned by Christine Koch.

This publication shall constitute as notice to each resident and each owner of real property within 5,000 feet of the perimeter of the proposed feedlot as required by Minnesota State Law.
