

**CITY OF BOCK
ORDINANCE NO. 2017-10
AN ORDINANCE TO
RESCIND ORDINANCE
NO. 2015-1 SECTION
23 ESTABLISHING
GAMBLING TAX TO BE
PAID TO THE CITY**

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Bock in regular session assembled, that:

WHEREAS, on September 14th, 2015 the Bock City Council adopted Ordinance No. 2015-1 which authorized the City to collect a 10% tax on profits from the organization operating within the city

WHEREAS, since the City does not have a way of lawfully using the money from the gambling tax the money will be refunded to the organization from whom the money was received.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED

that the City Council of the City of Bock hereby rescinds, repeals and revokes its legislation designated as Ordinance No. 2015-1 section 23 along with all authorizations empowered by its adoption and enactment.

BIT FURTHER ORDAINED
