

CITY OF PLYMOUTH PUBLIC NOTICE OF SHADE TREE DISEASE CONTROL ORDINANCE

The City of Plymouth has ordinance 2020.01-19, in conjunction with MN Statutes, Chapter 89, to control Hazardous, Dutch Elm, Oak Wilt and Emerald Ash Borer infected trees on public and private properties.

If a property owner has trees which are condemned, the owner will receive a notice from the Forestry Division to abate the situation. The notice will set an appropriate time limit based on current best management practices, outline options for removal, and the location for disposal of the diseased, infested, or hazardous trees. After the time limit expires, the city-hired contractor will be authorized to remove the trees. The City will charge the property owner for removal, plus an administrative fee of 25%, not to exceed \$100. Any questions may be directed to the City Forester at 763.509.5944.

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
