THAT pursuant to said Declaration, there is claimed to be due and owing as of April 2, 2018, from Kyle Walz, title holder, to Kollville Estates Homeowners Association, a Minnesota non-profit corporation, the amount of \$2,750.00, for assessments, late fees and collection costs, plus additional assessments and other amounts that may have accrued since the date of this notice, including the costs of collection and foreclosure;

THAT prior to the commencement of this foreclosure proceeding, Lienor complied with all notice requirements as required by statute; that no action or proceeding has been instituted at law or otherwise to recover the debt secured by said lien, or any part thereof;

THAT the owner has not been released from his financial obligation to pay said amount;

THAT pursuant to Minn.
