SUMMARY ORDINANCE NO. 331

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING MAPLE PLAIN CITY CODE REGARDING ZONING RELATED TO CANNABIS BUSINESSES

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on November 25, 2024, Ordinance No. 331, was adopted by the City Council of the City of Maple Plain, Minnesota.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that, because of the lengthy nature of Ordinance No. 331, the following summary of the ordinance has been prepared for publication.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the ordinance adopted by the City Council amends City Code Chapter 10, Article 4, of the Maple Plain Zoning Ordinance, by specifically defining and subsequently specifying approved zoning districts for cannabis business based on type of business within the city. The ordinance further stipulates the number of businesses that are permitted within the city based on type and also prescribes a buffer zone around schools, parks, day-care and similar locations. The city has also determined that all cannabis businesses defined in the ordinance shall be a conditional use requiring a conditional use permit.

A printed copy of the entire ordinance is available for inspection by any person during the City's regular office hours at the City of Maple Plain City Hall.
