ulatory Board (hereinafter EMSRB)
has received a completed appli-
cation from Children's Minnesota,
Minneapolis, Minnesota for a new
license to provide Advanced Life
Support Specialized (ALSS) ambu-
lance service statewide.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that,
pursuant to Minn. Stat 144E.11,
subd. 3, each municipality, county,
community health board, governing
body of a regional emergency med-
ical services system, ambulance
service and other person wishing to
make recommendations concern-
ing the disposition of the applica-
tion, shall make written recommen-
dations or comments opposing the
application to the EMSRB within 30
days or by April 24, 2018, at 4:30
p.m.

Written recommendations or
comments opposing the applica-
tion should be sent to: Tony
Spector, Executive Director, EMS-
RB, 2829 University Avenue S.E.,
Suite 310, Minneapolis, Minneso-
ta 55414-3222. If no more than
five comments opposing the ap-
plication are received during the
comment period, and the EMSRB
approves the application, the appli-
cant will be exempt from a contest-
ed case hearing, pursuant to Minn.
Stat. 144E.11, subd 4(a). If more
than five comments in opposition
to the application are received
during the comment period, or the
EMSRB denies the application, the
applicant may immediately request
a contested case hearing, or may
try to resolve the objections of the
public and/or the EMSRB within
30 days, pursuant to Minn. Stat.
144E.11, subd. 5(a)(b). If the appli-
cant is unable to resolve the objec-
tions within 30 days, or if the appli-
cant initially requests a contested
case hearing, one will be scheduled
and notice of the hearing given pur-
suant to Minn. Stat. 144E.11, subd.
5(c)-(e).
