ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 36 OF THE ST. LOUIS PARK CITY CODE RELATED **TO CANNABIS** LEGALIZATION

The ordinance amends the zoning code to include land use descriptions and regulations for businesses that engage in the cultivation, processing, manufacturing

or retail sale of cannabis and lower

potency hemp and related prod-

ucts. The ordinance permits can-

vertical mixed use and MX-2 neighborhood mixed use districts along with four existing planned unit developments that currently permit liquor stores. Cannabis retailers must locate a minimum of 1,000 feet from a school, 1,000 feet from another cannabis retailer and 1,000 feet from the commercial businesses from which the city already buffers liquor stores. The ordinance permits cannabis operations in the I-G general industrial district under the conditions that the property is a minimum of 1,000 feet from a school and 1,000 feet from another cannabis operation. On-site consumption of cannabis products may occur at food and beverage establishments located more than

300 feet from a school.
