

CITY OF PLYMOUTH WATER SERVICE LINE MATERIAL INVENTORY NOW AVAILABLE

Plymouth, Minn. - The City of Plymouth has completed and submitted its water service line materials inventory to the Minnesota Department of Health. The service line inventory is publicly available, and residents and business owners can check the materials for their service lines by visiting the Lead Inventory Tracking Tool at

<https://maps.umn.edu/LSL/> or by contacting the City of Plymouth Utilities Division at 763-509-5950. To complete the service line inventory, Plymouth reviewed existing records and requested information through an online survey to determine the status of service lines. The City of Plymouth has not identified any lead or galvanized service lines in the system. As of Aug. 30, 2024, the City of Plymouth's inventory contains 0 lead, 0 galvanized requiring replacement, 4,887 unknown material and 20,172 non-lead service lines.

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
