ORDINANCE NO. 800
AN ORDINANCE
ESTABLISHING CHARGES
FOR EMERGENCY
RESPONSE SERVICES**

The Baldwin Town Board, Sherburne County, Minnesota, now hereby ordains that on the 18th day of December 2017, the Town Board adopted the above Ordinance. Due to the lengthy content, a brief Summary follows:

Section 1: Finding, Purpose, and Intent - Identifies the purpose of the Ordinance

Section 2: Definitions - Clarifies language used in the Ordinance

Section 3: Conflicts - Identifies that that State law prevails over Ordinance

Section 4: Fire Charges In General - Identifies authority for collection, collection process and appeal process

Section 5: Fire Service Charges - Identifies the charges for fire responses and emergency services

Section 6: Repealer - Repeals all prior ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance

Section 7: Effective Date - Effective date of Ordinance

Ordinance No. 800, An Ordinance Establishing Charges for Emergency Response Services shall take effect and be in full force immediately following its adoption and upon publication. A copy of the Ordinance can be viewed during regular Township office hours. An additional copy of the Ordinance will also be on file at the local public library.
