ORDINANCE NO. 800  
AN ORDINANCE  
ESTABLISHING CHARGES  
FOR EMERGENCY  
RESPONSE SERVICES**

The Baldwin Town Board, Sherburne County, Minnesota, now hereby ordains that on the 18th day of December 2017, the Town Board adopted the above Ordinance. Due to the lengthy content, a brief Summary follows:

**Section 1: Finding, Purpose, and Intent -** Identifies the purpose of the Ordinance

**Section 2: Definitions -** Clarifies language used in the Ordinance

**Section 3: Conflicts -** Identifies that that State law prevails over Ordinance

**Section 4: Fire Charges In General -** Identifies authority for collection, collection process and appeal process

**Section 5: Fire Service Charges -** Identifies the charges for fire responses and emergency services

**Section 6: Repealer -** Repeals all prior ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance

**Section 7: Effective Date -** Effective date of Ordinance

Ordinance No. 800, An Ordinance Establishing Charges for Emergency Response Services shall take effect and be in full force immediately following its adoption and upon publication. A copy of the Ordinance can be viewed during regular Township office hours. An additional copy of the Ordinance will also be on file at the local public library.
