

**CITY OF MEDINA
ORDINANCE NO. 639
AN ORDINANCE
REGARDING PLANNING
COMMISSION
MEMBERSHIP
REQUIREMENTS;
AMENDING CHAPTER 8
OF THE CITY CODE**

The City Council of the City of Medina ordains as follows:

SECTION I. Subd. 1 of Section 825.33 of the code of ordinances of the City of Medina is amended by deleting the ~~struck through~~ language and adding the underlined language as follows:

Section 825.33. Planning Commission.

Subd. 1. Establishment. A planning commission of seven members is established and shall constitute the planning agency of the city. Members of the planning commission shall be persons who have resided in the city for at least ~~three~~ two years immediately preceding appointment. Members shall be appointed by the city council, shall serve staggered terms of three years and may be removed by a vote of two-thirds of the full city council. Terms shall begin January 1. No person shall serve more than nine consecutive years on the planning commission. Any person who has served nine consecutive years may be appointed again after an interruption in service of at least one year.

SECTION II. This ordinance shall become effective upon its adoption and publication.
