- Approved the following County Business Items: November 5, 2024, County Board Meeting Minutes and Minutes Summary, Personnel Action Items, Public Notice for Newspaper Bids, Set 2025 Fee Schedule Public Hearing, Acceptance of Donations to Isanti County, Utility Permits, and Claims and Warrants.

- Approved 2025 calendar year contracts between Health and Human Services and the following: Cambridge Medical Center for Day Treatment Services, Canvas Health to provide Child Protection Innovation Coordinator Services, and Allina Health for Behavioral Health Services, and approved contracts for calendar year 2025 between Isanti County Health and Human Services acting as the Fiscal Host for the Region 7 East Adult Mental Health Initiative with: Empower Recovery, Lakes and Pines CAC Inc., A Place for You, Stacy Johnstone, Ashley Wright, Cambridge-Isanti School District, Braham School District, Isanti County Probation Department, and Therapeutic Services Agency, Inc., Rise Inc. for Employment and Housing Services; approved the use of up to \$1,000.00 of the Opioid Funding to cover expenses involved in hosting the class action lawsuit required Community Forum which will be held on December 17, 2024; approved HHS vouchers and warrants as presented.

- Approved the final plat for Dan's Acres and Kleins Pines.
