(a) The issuance of permits and the collection of fees shall be as authorized in Minn. Stat. § 16B.62; subd. 1 326B.121, and as provided for in chapter 1 of the 1997 Uniforms Building Code and Minnesota Rules parts 1305.0106 and 1305.0107 in accordance with Minnesota Rules, accordance with Minnesota Rules, chapters 1300 and 1305.
