(EAW)

As the Responsible Governmental Unit (RGU), the City of Greenfield has ordered Superior Sand and Gravel to complete an EAW after receiving an application for a conditional use permit (CUP) to expand the gravel mining operations at the Crow Pit. The EAW for the Superior Sand and Gravel Crow Pit was reviewed and approved for release by the Greenfield City Council on October 1, 2024. The notice of document availability will be published in the EQB Monitor on October 15, 2024.

The Crow Pit gravel mine is located off Harff Road and Greenfield Road in Greenfield, Minnesota and is proposed to be expanded into an adjacent parcel west of the current site on an approximately 30- acre site. The address of the existing pit is 6675 Harff Road. The address of the proposed expansion is 6815 Harff Road. The expansion is a result of the depletion of usable aggregate at the existing mining site. The mining operation(s) would move into the new expansion area and Superior Sand and Gravel would continue reclamation of the existing site. Operations on the site would primarily include excavation of sand and gravel resources, and processing of the materials to produce aggregate products for use in area construction projects.
