

**TOWNSHIP OF LINWOOD

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING
AND AMENDING CHAPTER
5, PART 4 OF THE TOWN
CODE RELATING TO
THE FIRE CODE**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on the 9th day of January 2018, an ordinance entitled "Minnesota State Fire Code" was repealed and amended as "Fire Code" by the Town Board of Linwood, Minnesota. Due to the lengthy content of the Ordinance, a brief Summary follows:

The intent of Ordinance 162, Sections 1-7, Part 4, of Chapter 5 of the Linwood Town Code, Linwood Township Fire Code is to adopt the Minnesota State Fire Code and provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 88, Division of Forestry; Define open burning, recreational fires, enforcement and penalties. Contents: 504.01 Adoptions; 504.02 Fees; 504.03 Enforcement; 504.04 Open Burning and Prohibitions; 504.05 Recreational Fire Requirements; 504.06 Burning Ban or Air Quality Alert; and 504.07 Penalties.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage and publication, as required by law. A copy of the Ordinance can be viewed during office business hours at the Town Hall. An additional copy of the Ordinance will also be on file at the Anoka County Library, North Central branch and posted in the Township posting box.
