If any alteration, division, use, development or redevelopment occurs in violation of the Ordinance, the Township may, in addition to other remedies, institute any proper criminal action or proceedings in the name of Stillwater Township, and herby shall have the powers of a police officer to prevent such unlawful alteration, division, use, development or redevelopment; to restrain or correct such violations; to prevent occupancy of said property; or to prevent any illegal act, conduct business or use in or about said premises. Any person who violates a provision of the Ordinance is guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction thereof, shall be fined or penalized not more than the maximum levels established by the
