City Question 1 – Proposed Charter Amendment

Should the Brooklyn Center City Charter be amended to add language requiring the City to maintain a grant policy?

City Question 2 – Sales and Use Tax for Community Center
Improvements

Shall the Brooklyn Center City Charter be authorized to impose a temporary sales and use tax to finance all or a portion of the costs to renovate and expand the Brooklyn Center Community Center in an amount equal to one-half of one percent (0.50%) for up to 20 years or until \$44,000,000, plus interest and the cost of the issuing any bonds, is collected?
