ORDINANCE NO. 24-04

The City Council of the City of Columbus adopted Ordinance No. 24 -04 An Ordinance Amending Chapter 4 - Licensing and Chapter 7A - Zoning Regulations of the Columbus City Code for Cannabis Management Regulations on December 23, 2024, and approved this summary of the ordinance for publication. Ordinance No. 24-04 contains five sections, which are summarized as follows:

SECTION I. Chapter 4 Licensing of the City Code is amended by adding Article X Cannabis, establishing Section 4-1000 through 4-1017. Article X includes definitions and licensing provisions for cannabis retail sales and cannabis temporary events.

SECTION II. Article II Definitions of Chapter 7A Zoning Regulations is amended by adding cannabis management definitions and a non-substantive reorganizational amendment.

SECTION III. Article VI & VII Provisions for Official Zoning Map Establishment and Purpose of Districts of Chapter 7A Zoning Regulations is amended by adding various cannabis business classifications as Conditional Uses or Interim Uses in various commercial and industrial zoning districts within the City.

SECTION IV. Article VIII General Provisions and Performance Standards of Chapter 7A Zoning Regulations is amended by adding Section 7A-825 Cannabis Management.

SECTION V. Ordinance No. 24-04 was adopted on December 23, 2024 and shall become effective upon publication.
