

CITY OF RUSH CITY PUBLIC NOTICE FOR WATER SYSTEM USERS

The City of Rush City has completed and submitted our service line materials inventory to the Minnesota Department of Health. The service line inventory is publicly available, and you can check the materials for your service line by visiting the Lead Inventory Tracking Tool (LITT) at <https://maps.umn.edu/LSL/> or you may also contact us at City Hall at 320-358-4743. To complete the service line inventory, our system mailed letters to all properties connected to the city's water system requesting that they self-identify the material of their service line or schedule an appointment to have City staff or the City's engineering firm's (SEH) staff inspect their service line. We also looked through historical records to identify properties constructed and water mains replaced after 1985, when the use of lead was banned in Minnesota. Multiple articles regarding the inventory and the request for property owner's participation in identifying their service line were published in the City's newsletter Dateline, and posted on City's website and Facebook page. As of October 21, 2024, our inventory contains 1 lead, 2 galvanized requiring replacement, 491 unknown material, and 415 non-lead service lines.
