Notice is hereby given that the City Council of the City of Brooklyn Center, Minnesota, adopted Ordinance No. 2018-14 at their November 13, 2018, City Council meeting. This ordinance raises the minimum legal sale of tobacco related products age limit from 18 to 21 years of age; limit the number of licenses to 15; restrict the sale of all electronic cigarettes and vaping products to adult tobacco shops; and increase training of retail staff and increase application and penalty fees.
