Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received, and opened by City staff at the City Hall at 430 Third Street in said City at 10:00 a.m. on February 19, 2019 for furnishing of all work and materials for consideration of City Improvement No. 18-03 and consisting of approximately:

- 1 LS –PITLESS ADAPTER
- 1 LS – SUBMERSIBLE PUMP, MOTOR (200 HP), AND DROP PIPE ASSEMBLY
- 1 LS – BURIED CHECK VALVE MANHOLE
- 1 LS – BURIED METER MANHOLE
- 1 LS – CONSTRUCT APPROX. 12' X 18' 8" MASONRY CAVITY
WALL ADDITION TO WELL 8/9 PUMPING FACILITY
- 1 LS – CHEMICAL FEED SYSTEMS INCLUDING CHLORINE GAS, FLUORIDE, AND POLYPHOSPHATE
- 175 LF – WATERMAIN ADDITION
- 1,500 SF – BITUMINOUS PAVEMENT REPLACEMENT
- INCLUDING ALL RELATED WORK AND APPURTENANCES.

Plans and Specifications incorporating the work for the projects may be examined at the City Hall at the Office of the City Engineer. PAPER COPIES may be obtained from the City for \$50 a set, which is not refundable. ELECTRONIC COPIES may be obtained at QuestCDN.com (eBidDoc #XXXXXXX for \$25 a set, which is not refundable.

Bids must be on the basis of cash payment for the work and materials, and no bid will be considered unless sealed and filed with the City Engineer or his designee, and endorsed upon the outside wrapper with a brief statement of summary as to the work for which the bid is made, and accompanied by a cash deposit, certified check, or bidder's bond, payable to the City, for not less than 5%, as a guarantee that the bidder will, within TEN (10) days after notification of the award of contract, enter into an agreement with the City and furnish a bond for the full amount of the contract as provided by law. This deposit will be subject to forfeiture as provided for by law. Cash deposits, certified checks, and bidder's bonds of the three (3) lowest bidders may be retained until the contract has been awarded and executed, but not longer than 60 days from the date of opening bids. All other deposits will be refunded promptly. The City reserves the right to reject any and all bids, to waive any informality therein, and to adjourn the meeting to a later date for the purpose of further consideration of the bids and taking action thereon. No bid may be withdrawn within 60 days from date of opening of bids.

The City Water Board will consider award of contracts at their regular meeting held on February 25, 2019, at 7:00 p.m. in the City Hall at 430 3rd St, Farmington, Minnesota. It is the City's intent to begin construction by March 13, 2019, and all work to be completed by June 28, 2019.
