MUNICIPAL OFFICE**

Notice is hereby given that the City of Brooklyn Center will accept Affidavits of Candidacy for the following municipal offices to be voted upon in the General Election to be held November 6, 2018:

One (1) Mayor (four-year term commencing on January 7, 2019)

Two (2) Council Members (four-year term commencing on January 7, 2019)

Candidate eligibility requirements are: 1) eligible to vote in Minnesota; 2) 21 years of age or more upon assuming office; and 3) reside in Brooklyn Center for at least 30 days before the General Election.

Individuals who are eligible and desire to become a candidate for the office of Mayor or Council Member must file an Affidavit of Candidacy, along with the \$25 filing fee or Petition In Place Of Filing Fee signed by 50 registered voters on behalf of the candidate, at the City Clerk's Office, City Hall, 6301 Shingle Creek Parkway, beginning 8:00 a.m., Tuesday, May 22, 2018, and ending 5:00 p.m., Tuesday, June 5, 2018. Filing offices will be closed Monday, May 28, 2018, in observance of Memorial Day.

A candidate for municipal office who will be absent from the state during the filing period may submit a properly executed affidavit of candidacy and the appropriate filing fee, or Petition In Place Of Filing Fee signed by 50 registered voters on behalf of the candidate, in person to the City Clerk. The candidate shall state in writing the reason for being unable to submit the affidavit during the filing period. The affidavit and filing fee must be submitted to the City Clerk during the seven days immediately preceding the candidate's absence from the state.

Affidavits can be withdrawn up to 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, June 7, 2018.
