NOTICE OF PUBLIC
HEARING ON THE
CITY'S FIVE-YEAR
STREET IMPROVEMENT
AND RECONSTRUCTION
PLAN**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council (the "Council") of the City of Robbinsdale, Minnesota (the "City") will meet in the Council Chambers of City Hall, 4100 Lakeview Avenue North in said City, on Tuesday, the 18th of December 2018 at or after 7:00 p.m. for a Public Hearing to receive comments relating to the City's proposed Five-Year Street Improvement and Reconstruction Plan (the "Plan"). Copies of the Plan will be available for public inspection in the office of the City Clerk after December 7, 2018, during normal business hours of the City.

The Plan proposes to finance a portion of the cost of various street improvement and reconstruction projects by the issuance of general obligation bonds (the "Bonds") under the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 475, including Section 475.58, Subdivision 3(b), as amended. The Bonds will not be issued without approval of the voters at a special election if a petition requesting such an election is signed by a number of voters equal to five percent (5%) of the votes cast in the last general City election is filed with the City Clerk within 30 days after the Public Hearing.

Any person wishing to express a view about the Plan may present written or oral testimony at the public hearing.
