All interim uses as listed below
must comply with the provisions of
Section 807.12 of the Town Code
and meet the intent of the Compre-

hensive Plan. Multi-Family Residential provided that: i. Applicants and/or Property Owner meet all applicable require-ments of the Township's Housing Ordinance for Rental Housing con-tained in Section 509 of the Town

Code. ii. Adequate off-street parking and access is provided to the site or on lots directly abutting or di-rectly across a public street to the dwelling. Adequate iii. sanitary

sewer iiii. Adequate santary sewer service and plumbing facilities are serving all rental dwelling units.

C. Chapter 8, Part 7, Section 8 of the Town Code, the "R-1" Single Family Residential District is amended to insert the following.

hensive Plan. Multi-Family Residential provided that:

ii. Adequate off-street parking and access is provided to the site or on lots directly abutting or di-rectly across a public street to the

dwelling.

iii. Adequate sanitary sewer service and plumbing facilities are serving all rental dwelling units.
