Members Present: M a y o r Marlys Palmer, Council Members Joe Morin, Lisa Iverson, Jim Godfrey and Kersten Conley. All present, no absences

- Meeting called to order at 6:01 pm.

- Angela Taylor and Eric Nelson spoke on behalf of Industries Inc. and received council permission to use sidewalk chalk to place positive messages on City sidewalks the week of September 9 – 15, 2018 for Suicide Prevention Week.

- Agenda and Consent Agenda were approved. Consent agenda item F was amended to only include the hiring of the part-time patrol officer since the full-time patrol officer candidate withdrew his application.

- Palmer proclaimed September 10 – 14, 2018 as “Change to Chill Week”.

- Approved a Memorandum of Agreement with the Initiative Foundation setting up a Long-Term Recovery Fund.

- Approved the removal of the development signs for the Parkwood Development on the north side of the development since the signs are located in the City’s right-of-way.

- Approved Resolution R18-057 Policy for Donation of Surplus Equipment.

- Approved Resolution No. R18-058 changing the name of the plat from The Preserve Phase II to Roosevelt Gardens and officially approved the final plat of Roosevelt Gardens.

- Approved Resolution R18-059 approving an Interim Use Permit adding a third condition “There shall be no business hours after 10:00 pm” for Carollynn Thomas, Butterfly’s Massage, at 211 Cleveland St. S.

- Approved Ordinance No. 677 approving the amendments to Title XV: Land Usage, Chapter 156 Zoning, Section 156.060 Off-Street Parking Requirements.

- Council convened into closed session at 7:41 pm

- Adjourned closed session and regular meeting at 8:10 pm.

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
