AND AMENDING THE CITY'S
FEE SCHEDULE TO SET A
FEE FOR SIGN PERMITS.
PUBLIC NOTICE**

The City Council of the City of the Village of Minnetonka Beach has adopted Ordinance No. 118, 2nd Series, an ordinance to amend sign regulations within the City of the Village of Minnetonka Beach, including the relocation of parking regulations currently within the sign ordinance, and to amend the city's fee schedule to set a fee for sign permits. The ordinance was necessary to bring the City's sign regulations into compliance with recent court decisions dictating how Cities can and cannot regulate signs, and was guided by the League of Minnesota Cities paper on Sign Ordinances and the First Amendment. The new regulations adopt standards for the amount of signage different uses may have, and does not regulate signs based on the message of the sign. Permitted and prohibited sign types are identified; and sign standards such as setbacks, placement, height, and maintenance requirements are all included in this ordinance. The full ordinance text is available for inspection at Village Hall during regular business hours, and will be emailed or sent to any party upon request.
