BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, that the Princeton Township Board of Supervisors, Mille Lacs County, Minnesota do hereby establish a

Subordinate Service District pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 365A with the following stipulations and conditions.

A. The following Subordinate Service District is created and established for the area legally described below and graphically depicted on

the map attached hereto as Exhibit A.

The portion of 33rd St., east of County Road 4 to the dead end and 92rd Aug. ports of Princeton eith limits to 26th St.

82nd Ave., north of Princeton city limits to 36th St.

B. The purpose of this Subordinate Service District is for Blacktopping roads for the benefit of all identified property owners in the above

described Subordinate Service District.

C. The Subordinate Service District will be financed as follows: Through Bonds and Loans which will be re-paid through property tax charges and/or service charges against the benefited landowners in the Subordinate Service District, or a combination of property tax, service charge or by any combination of the above.

 D. The Board of Supervisors shall establish rules and regulations for the operations and maintenance for the District.

E. The Subordinate Service District shall become effective upon passage of sixty (60) days from the publication of this notice.

F. The Town Clerk shall cause this Resolution to be published and shall give mailed notice as required by law.
