AND VARIANCES, SUBJECT TO APPEAL; AND ESTABLISHING A REASONABLE ACCOMODATION PROCESS IN THE CITY CODE, THEREBY AMENDING CHAP-TERS 2, 15, 19, 21, AND APPEN-DIX A OF THE CITY CODE."
