MAKES THE FOLLOWING RE-
QUIREMENTS APPLY TO BOTH
PARTIES TO THIS ACTION, UN-
LESS THEY ARE MODIFIED BY
THE COURT OR THE PROCEED-
ING IS DISMISSED:

(1) NEITHER PARTY MAY DIS-
POSE OF ANY ASSETS EXCEPT
(I) FOR THE NECESSITIES OF LIFE
OR FOR THE NECESSARY GEN-
ERATION OF INCOME OR PRES-
ERVATION OF ASSETS, (II) BY AN
AGREEMENT IN WRITING, OR (iii)
FOR RETAINING COUNSEL TO
CARRY ON OR TO CONTEST THIS
PROCEEDING;

(2) NEITHER PARTY MAY HA-
RASS THE OTHER PARTY; AND

(3) ALL CURRENTLY AVAIL-
ABLE INSURANCE COVERAGE
MUST BE MAINTAINED AND
CONTINUED WITHOUT CHANGE
IN COVERAGE OR BENEFICIARY
DESIGNATION.

IF YOU VIOLATE ANY OF
THESE PROVISIONS. YOU WILL
BE SUBJECT TO SANCTIONS BY
THE COURT.

(4) PARTIES TO A MARRIAGE
DISSOLUTION PROCEEDING ARE
ENCOURAGED TO

ATTEMPT ALTERNATIVE DIS-
PUTE RESOLUTION PURSUANT
TO MINNESOTA LAW. ALTERNA-
TIVE DISPUTE RESOLUTION IN-
CLUDES MEDIATION, ARBITRA-
TION, AND OTHER PROCESSES
AS SET FORTH IN THE DISTRICT
COURT RULES. YOU MAY CON-
TACT THE COURT ADMINISTRA-
TOR ABOUT RESOURCES IN
YOUR AREA. IF YOU CANNOT PAY
FOR MEDIATION OR ALTERNATIVE
DISPUTE RESOLUTION, IN SOME
COUNTIES, ASSISTANCE MAY BE
AVAILABLE TO YOU THROUGH
A NONPROFIT PROVIDER OR A
COURT PROGRAM. IF YOU ARE
A VICTIM OF DOMESTIC ABUSE
OR THREATS OF ABUSE AS DE-
FINED IN MINNESOTA STATUTES,
CHAPTER 518B, YOU ARE NOT
REQUIRED TO TRY MEDIATION
AND YOU WILL NOT BE PENAL-
IZED BY THE COURT IN LATER
PROCEEDINGS.
