Members Present: Mayor Marlys Palmer, Council Members Joe Morin, Kersten Conley, Lisa Iverson, and Jim Godfrey. No absences.

- Meeting called to order at 3:30 pm.

- Agenda and Consent Agenda were approved.

- The School District reported the bus drop-off and pick-up changes have gone very well and they will continue to use the same pattern.

- Authorized the placement of a "Stop Here for Pedestrian" sign at the intersection of Winnetka and 8th and to send a letter to the school district encouraging them to place a crossing guard at that intersection along with directing the Chief of Police to increase enforcement at that intersection.

- Approved Resolution R18-053 Approving the Cambridge Fire Department Relief Association Service Pension Benefit Amount.

- Approved the Memorandum of Understanding and renewed a three-year contract for School Resource Officer services with the School District.

- Discussed needed repairs at Woodcrest Park Church which is City owned property. Council will meet at the property on Monday, August 20th for a tour.

- Approved the Mortgage, Loan Agreement, and Promissory Note, authorized the Mayor and City Administrator to sign the necessary documents and authorize City Attorney Jay Squires and staff to make minimal changes to the agreements that do not affect the major business terms with Stars Hollow Limited.

- Approved the Town Line Road Agreement with Cambridge Township.

- Reviewed which parties the Council would attend on National Night Out.

- Concern was raised with the outside trim at City Hall. Staff will bring quotes back to Council for their consideration.
