CITY OF MOUND Ordinance 03-2018 has been approved by the City Council of the City of Mound. The Ordinance amends Chapter 129 the Mound City Code to prohibit the short-term rental of dwellings in any residential zoning district. Short-term rentals are for periods of less than 30 days. The prohibition does not apply to licensed hotels, motels, and lodging establishment. The ordinance also adds language about allowed uses and a process to request a determination of whether a use is substantially similar to an existing
