The Township is concerned

THE TOWN BOARD MARES THE FOLLOWING FINDINGS:

1. The Township is concerned that existing ordinance provisions may allow cul-de-sacs that hinder public safety vehicles, create additional maintenance burdens, and are contrary to sound planning and zoning principles;

2. The Township desires to impose a moratorium on cul-de-sacs within the Township, prohibiting the creation of new cul-de-sacs and extensions of existing cul-de-sacs during the study period;

3. An interim ordinance, pursuant to Minnesota Statutes §
462.355, is necessary to restrict potential cul-de-sacs from additional problems during the time of the study.

tional problems during the time of the study.

4. The Township finds that this moratorium will protect the plan-ning process and the health, safety, and welfare of its citizens. NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to Minnesota Statute § 462.355 Subd. 4, the Princeton Town Board of Su-pervisors, approves the following pervisors approvinterim ordinance: SECTION 1: approves the following

pervisors approves the following interim ordinance:
SECTION 1: A moratorium prohibiting the creation of new culde-sacs or the extension of existing cul-de-sacs for a period of twelve months from the effective date of this Ordinance, or until such time as the Board of Supervisors determines the moratorium is no longer necessary in Princeton Township.
SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its passage and publication. This Ordinance may be extended pursuant to Minnesota Statutes § 462.355, Subd. 4.
SECTION 3: Every section, provision, or part of this Ordinance is declared severable from every other section, provision, or part thereof to the extent that if any section, provision, or part of this Interim Ordinance shall be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not invalidate any other section, provision, or part thereof.
SECTION 4: The Township may enforce this Ordinance by injunction or any other appropriate civil remedy in any court of competent jurisdiction. A violation of this Interim Ordinance shall constitute a misdemeanor. Each day a violation occurs shall be considered a separate offense.

SECTION 5: At least four-fifths of the Township Board's members direct the Clear

strain be considered a separate offense.

SECTION 5: At least four-fifths of the Township Board's members direct the Clerk to publish only the title and a summary of this Ordinance as follows:

"AN INTERIM ORDINANCE RESTRICTING CUL-DE-SACS WITHIN THE PRINCETON TOWN-SHIP. It is the intent and effect of this Ordinance to prohibit all new cul-de-sacs or extensions of existing cul-de-sacs until Princeton Township can study the effects of cul-de-sacs and ensure that zoning regulations adequately protect
