RESOLUTION APPROVING SUMMARY LANGUAGE FORPUBLICATION OF AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TOWN OF WEST LAKELAND CODE OF ORDINANCE REGARDING CANNABIS BUSINESSES

WHEREAS, the Town Board of West Lakeland Township ("Town") has adopted Ordinance No. 2024-04, "An Ordinance Amending the Town of

West Lakeland Code of Ordinances Regarding Cannabis Businesses" ("Ordinance"); WHEREAS, it is not practical to publish the entire text of the Ordinance

in the Town's official newspaper;

WHEREAS, Minnesota Statute, sections 365.125, subdivision 2 and 368.01, subdivision 21 allows the publication of a summary of an ordi-

nance instead of publishing the entire ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board determines publication of a summary of the Ordinance is sufficient to clearly inform the public of the intent and effect of the Ordinance and where to access the full text of the Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board hereby determines to publish the following summary language, which is hereby approved, in lieu of publishing the full text of the Ordinance:

TOWN OF WEST LAKELAND CODE OF ORDINANCES REGARDING CANNABIS BUSINESSES

On December 9, 2024, the Town Board of West Lakeland Township ad-

opted the above-referenced ordinance to amend the Town of West Lakeland Code of Ordinances to establish definitions and impose zoning regulations on cannabis businesses within the Town. The ordinance allows cannabis businesses in the Highway Commercial/Business District with

the issuance of an interim use permit. The ordinance establishes buffer distances, imposes certain performance standards for such businesses. and prohibits the use of cannabis in public places. The ordinance is effective immediately and the full text of the ordinance is posted on the Town's website, is available by contacting the Town Clerk, and a copy of the ordi-
