NOTICE **DELINQUENT UTILITY BILLS TO BE CERTIFIED** TO PROPERTY TAXES Minnesota Statute 444,075 and

CITY OF RICHFIELD

Chapter VII of the Richfield Code of Ordinances provides that unpaid water and sewer charges may be

certified to the County Auditor to be included in a property owner's annual property tax bill. The City

Code also authorizes a \$50.00 certification fee to be charged against each delinquent account. By certifying the delinquent charges to the property taxes for the delinquent

properties, the City is assured of ultimately collecting the delinguent charges. For 2018, there are presently 1009 utility accounts that remain

unpaid and are to be certified at the September 25, 2018 City Council meeting. The total to be certified to

the 2019 property tax roll, including the certification fee, is \$518,158.35.
