According to data released by the Minnesota Department of Health, vaccination rates for several schools in Morrison County were below the 90-95% herd immunity rate, recommended to help prevent outbreaks and keep unvaccinated people safe in 2014 ... Warren John Okerman, 46, Little Falls, pleaded guilty to one felony count of third-degree sale of a controlled substance. The controlled substance charge was amended from a charge of third-degree murder in the death of Leslie Peterson, who was found dead June 2, 2012, the day after she had ingested methamphetamine Okerman had provided ... The masonry restoration project for Morrison County's 124-year-old historic courthouse attracted bids of up to \$737,000. From the 16 bids received, the low bid of \$134,000 from Midland Restoration of Ft. Scott, Kansas, was approved by the Morrison County Board of Commissioners ... The Pierz City Council approved an ordinance to establish and erect a veterans memorial in Billig Park in Pierz ... Morrison County Social Services and CHI St. Gabriel's Health partnered to help combat prescription abuse and to assess the services needed for disabled and elderly to allow them to stay in their homes ... The Royalton fifth-grade girls basketball team took first place in a Royalton tournament. The team defeated Pequot Lakes B, Sauk Rapids and in the championship game defeated Pequot Lakes A in overtime.
