Craig Conklin enlisted in the US Navy in 1966 as a Nuclear Machinist Mate. He attended Machinist Mate A School, Nuclear Power School, Nuclear Power Prototype Training, Engineering Laboratory Technician School and Submarine School. He was subsequently assigned to the USS Sunfish, SSN649 a nuclear attack submarine where he qualified in submarines in 1970. His next assignment was the USS Fulton, AS-11, a nuclear submarine repair tender where routine maintenance was performed on nuclear submarines.

His enlistment ended in 1974.

The next 25 years were spent at various civilian nuclear power stations, as well as the Nuclear Regulatory Commission, where he was responsible for engineering and nuclear safety. He earned this Bachelor of Science in Operations Management in 1986.

He retired to Florida in 1999.

He spent the next 15 years as a Board Certified Licensed Hearing Aid Specialist finally retiring in 2016. He currently lives in Shirleysburg, PA, with his wife of 57 years Linda, dog Mork and cats Mindy and Spot. He has two children, 4 grand children and 5 great grand children.
