**GENERAL PRIMARY NOTICE FOR MAY 19, 2026 PRIMARY**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF** Section 905 of the Act of June 3, 1937, P.L. 1333, as amended, known as the Pennsylvania Election Code, that nominations are to be made to fill the following named offices at the General Primary to be held throughout Blair County at the regular polling places on Tuesday, May 19, 2026 A.D. between the hours of 7 o'clock a.m. and 8 o'clock p.m. (prevailing time) and elected to office at the General Election on Tuesday, November 3, 2026. Nominations may be made by the Democratic and Republican Parties.

**By the electors of each certified political party of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania:**

- One (1) person for the office of Governor
- One (1) person for the office of Lieutenant Governor

**By the electors of each certified political party of the 13th Congressional District, including all of Blair County:**

- One (1) person for the office of Representative in Congress

**By the electors of each certified political party of the 79th Legislative District composed of the City of Altoona, Allegheny Township, Logan Township and the Borough of Tunnelhill (Blair County portion):**

- One (1) person for the office of Representative in the General Assembly

**By the electors of each certified political party of the 80th Legislative District composed of the Boroughs of Bellwood, Duncansville, Hollidaysburg, Martinsburg, Newry, Roaring Spring, Tyrone and Williamsburg, and the Townships of Antis, Blair, Catharine, Frankstown, Freedom, Greenfield, Huston, Juniata, North Woodbury, Snyder, Taylor, Tyrone, and Woodbury:**

- One (1) person for the office of Representative in the General Assembly

**By the electors of the Democratic Party of the County of Blair:**

- One (1) person for State Committee – 4 Year Term
- Two (2) persons from each election district for Democratic County Committee – 4 Year Term

**By the electors of the Republican Party of the County of Blair:**

- Five (5) people for State Committee (2 Male, 2 Female and 1 either gender) – 4 Year Term

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN**, in accordance with the provisions of the Section 915 of Act No. 320, known as the Pennsylvania Election Code that Friday, March 13, 2026, at 1:30 p.m. in Commissioner's Meeting Room,(basement) Blair County Courthouse, Hollidaysburg, PA has been set for the time and place for drawing of lots to determine the position of names upon the Primary ballot for Democratic County Committee candidates.

All candidates may appear in person or by agent duly authorized by candidate. In the event of any candidate not being present in person or by representative at the time of drawing of lots, the County Board of Elections will appoint someone from the Election Board to represent such absentees.
