Contest Rules

There is no charge for these blanks and no purchase need be made to obtain one. Merely visit one of these firms and ask for a "Daily News Football Contest Blank." Entry blanks not listing advertiser names will be disqualified.
3. No contestant may submit more than one entry a week under his own or any other name.
4. All entries must be received in The Daily News office in Huntingdon before 4 p.m. on Friday of the week the games are to be played.
5. In case of ties, a drawing will be held.
6. Instructions for filling out the entry blank, printed on the blanks, must be followed to avoid disqualifications. The proper team must correspond with the proper advertiser or the entry will be disqualified.
7. Names of the prize winners will be announced in The Daily News.
8. Contest winners will receive gift certificates equivalent to amount of prize.
9. All entries must also include the scores of both teams in the special tie-breaker game. The contest winner or winners will be selected from the contestants picking the most number of team winners in the 11 game contest, then, if two or more contestants tie in the number of games named correctly, the actual scores of the two teams in the TIE-BREAKER GAME with the contestant picking the closest score will win.

Ex: Two contestants miss a total of three games in the 11 game contest, the "A" contestant calls the tie-breaker game as 21 to 14 score (when actually the game was 14 to 6).
