Basis of Authority:

- The state of Idaho under authority of Idaho Code § 63-1311 provides that the governing board of any taxing district may impose and cause to be collected fees for services provided which would otherwise be funded by property tax revenues; and
- This Recreation District also has authority, pursuant to Idaho Code §31-4317 (m) and (q) to fix and collect fees and charges for the use of the district's facilities, and to reduce or waive the same as to any person not reasonably able to pay, and to exercise such other powers as may be conferred by law.
- The above referenced Increased fees and new fees have been preliminarily determined by the Board of Commissioners to be reasonable in relationship to the cost of providing the services by the Recreation District; and,
- All persons are invited to attend the public hearing and to provide comment on the proposed fees to be established.
