PEACE VALLEY CHARTER SCHOOL ADVERTISEMENT NOTICE FOR BIDS

Notice is hereby given that the Peace Valley Charter School, Boise, Idaho will receive sealed bids for providing Student Transportation Services. Bids will be received until 10:00 A.M. on **Monday, July 6, 2026**, at the School Office, 1845 S Federal Way, Boise, Idaho 83705. Bids will be opened and read at 10:00 A.M. on **Monday, July 6, 2026**. Bids will be reviewed by the Transportation Selection Committee, which will make a recommendation to the Board of Directors. A bid award is initially scheduled for **Monday, July 13, 2026**, however the School reserves the right to extend the bid award date for a period of 45 days from the date the bids were opened.

To receive a bid package, it is mandatory that all prospective bidders submit in writing a letter of intent, stating their interest in and/or their intent to place a bid. The letter of intent must be addressed to **Sita Chiang, Principal** and must be received by email (s.chiang@boisewaldorf.org) or mail to the above address on or before **Saturday, June 20, 2026, by 5:00 P.M.** The letter of intent must be clearly marked, "PROSPECTIVE BIDDER FOR STUDENT TRANSPORTATION SERVICES" and include the following:

- Name of Bidder
- Address of Bidder
- Phone # of Bidder
- Contact person for Bidder
- Statement of Intent to Bid and/or the Request to Receive the Bid Procedures and Specifications

Bid procedures and specifications, as well as all other necessary forms will be available to potential bidders who have met all initial mandatory requirements, at the Peace Valley Charter School Office, 1845 S Federal Way, Boise, Idaho 83705 or by email upon request.

Bidders are required to furnish a bid bond in the form of a certified check, a cashier's check, or a bid bond executed by a qualified surety company made payable to Peace Valley Charter School, in the amount of not less than 5% of the first year's route cost proposal, as calculated on the Bid Bond Calculation Form. No interest will be allowed on bid bond. This bond shall be forfeited by the Bidder in event of failure to fulfill provisions of bid as awarded.

The bid shall be awarded to the "Lowest Responsive Responsible Bidder" as determined by the Board of Directors. Bid award will not be based on cost alone, but on a complete evaluation of the entire bid submitted, as per the Bid Procedures and Specifications. The Board of Directors for Peace Valley Charter School reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids, to waive any or all informalities in any bid or in the bid process, deemed to be in the best interest of **Peace Valley Charter School**.

In the interest of maintaining continued services, School will award the contract for Student Transportation Services for a five (5) year period July 1, 2026 – June 30, 2031. The contract entered into by the Board of Directors for Student Transportation Services shall be in writing and in a form approved by the State Department of Education.

At the end of the initial contract period, pursuant to Idaho Code, Section 33-1510, the Board of Directors may renegotiate terms satisfactorily to Peace Valley Charter School, with the successful Contractor and renew the contract for a term not to exceed five (5) years. The contract entered into by the Board of Directors for Student Transportation Services shall be in writing and in a form approved by the State Department of Education.
