

THE NUMBERS

Here's how much of Idaho's \$200 million in Emergency Rental Assistance Funds have been spent since January, and how they break down:

Idaho Housing & Finance Association

Spent: **\$10.1 million**

Portion paid out for rent: \$9.6 million

Portion paid out for utilities: \$527,432

Households helped: 2,548

BCACHA, City of Boise

Spent: **\$6.5 million**

Portion paid out for rent: 6.2 million

Portion paid out for utilities: \$294,116

Households helped: 1,291

BCACHA, Ada County

Spent: **\$3.2 million**

Portion paid out for rent: \$3.1 million

Portion paid out for utilities: \$103,310

Households helped: 584
