MERIDIAN CEMETERY SUPPLEMENTAL LEVY

Shall the Board of Commissioners of the Meridian Cemetery Maintenance District be authorized and empowered to levy a supplemental levy as permitted by law in Section 27-121(2), Idaho Code in the amount of seventy thousand dollars (\$70,000) each year for a period of ten years for a total of seven hundred thousand dollars (\$700,000) commencing with the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2015, and ending December 30, 2024, for the sole and express purpose of paying all lawful expenses of acquiring burial ground.
