The City of Calipatria anticipates submitting an application requesting program funding during the 8th Cycle Active Transportation Program (ATP) administered by the Division of Local Assistance and Office of State Programs. The main goal of the ATP is to increase use of active, non-motorized modes of transportation throughout the state, such as walking, biking, and rolling.

City staff have identified six potential project sites for ATP funding. All six sites consist of the construction of new sidewalks, curbs, and gutters. To meet the public participation requirements, the city will conduct public outreach activities. These activities will consist of a public hearing and informative workshops. Outreach activities will be conducted between the 13th and 25th of May. All comments and suggestions will be compiled and presented to the City Council during a public hearing on the 26th of May.
