NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING CITY COUNCIL CITY OF CALEXICO

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the City of Calexico will hold a Public Hearing on Wednesday, September 2, 2026, at 6:30 PM (or as soon thereafter as the agenda permits), in the Fernando "Nene" Torres Council Chambers, 608 Heber Avenue, Calexico, CA 92231, to consider the following project:

PROJECT TITLE: Zoning Ordinance Amendment

APPLICANT: City of Calexico

LOCATION: This affects all properties within the City of Calexico.

DESCRIPTION: The City Council will consider a proposed amendment to Title 17 (Zoning) of the Calexico Municipal Code to prohibit Data Centers as a permitted or conditionally permitted land use within all zoning districts of the City. The proposed amendment would expressly provide that data centers are not allowed in any zoning district unless and until authorized by a future amendment to the Municipal Code.

CEQA: The proposed zoning ordinance amendment is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guidelines sections 15061(b)(3) and 15378 as the amendment does not have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment and does not have the potential to result in either a direct or reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change to the environment.
