## PRESS RELEASE May 30, 2026

Today, May 30, 2026, this office authorized the Virginia State Police to obtain felony warrants related to a horrific crash on Interstate I-95 on May 29, 2026.

That crash involved multiple vehicles and resulted in the deaths of five (5) individuals, as well as serious injuries to others.

The investigation is ongoing, but evidence gathered since the crash has established that a tour bus, travelling southbound at a high rate of speed, struck one or more vehicles that were moving slowly through a work zone, causing a chain reaction crash involving at least 8 vehicles.

Even as the Virginia State Police continues to conduct a complex investigation, I have determined that probable cause presently exists to establish that the driver of the tour bus caused this crash and, at the time of the crash, he was driving in a criminally negligent manner.

Felony warrants for two counts of Involuntary Manslaughter have been obtained and have been served on the driver of the tour bus, Jing Sheng Dong, a 48 year old man from Staten Island NY. Each count of Involuntary Manslaughter carries a maximum period of confinement of 10 years in prison.

Jing Sheng Dong, who suffered injuries from the crash, was arrested today by the Virginia State Police and was served with the felony warrants in the hospital. At this time, a magistrate has determined that he will be held without bond pending his appearance in Court. He remains hospitalized, but he is in custody.

The defendant will have his first appearance in Court after his release from the hospital.

The investigation continues.
