





TAWAS POINT STATE PARK

Often referred to as the "Cape Cod of the Midwest" this state park is home to the Tawas Point Lighthouse and is a favorite destination of water sport enthusiasts and bird watchers. Situated on a 200-acre sandy point, there is a long natural beach, marked swimming area, gift shop, bathrooms, modern campground with overnight lodging rentals, hiking trails, and many recreational programs. Park access requires a Recreational Pass.

In operation from 1876 to 2016, the Tawas Point Lighthouse is a popular and fascinating attraction for maritime enthusiasts. The lighthouse Keepers Program and the lighthouse are open to the public during the months of May to October. Admission is by donation with the funds going to the Friends of Tawas Point. 

Note: The following information is a compilation of information reported in the *losco County News* from 1955-1959, plus a book by Neil Thornton in 1991 entitled *Around the Bay*, published by Printer's Devil Press, Tawas City. Additional research assistance and photographs provided by Lauri Finnerty of the Huron Shores Genealogical Society, and Jeff Schlagel, vice president of losco County Historical Society.

On Jan. 27, 1955, *The losco County News* announced that the famous Great Lakes cruise ship, the *SS Western States* would be coming to Tawas Bay. The *SS Western States* was a 350-foot long, 44-foot wide, and 19-foot, six-inch deep steam ship with a 42,000-horsepower engine.

Originating in the 19th century, the SS designation was used on civilian ships and indicated that the ship was a steamship that used steam as a method of propulsion. A steam powered ship was

considered state of the art at that time.

The SS Western States was a luxurious passenger cruise ship that served the Great Lakes with stops in Detroit, Cleveland, St. Joseph, Chicago, Mackinac Island, etc. from 1902 to 1950. During

those years, it was common to travel overnight by ship.

Starting in the 1940s, Michigan built freeways in the Detroit area, such as the Davison Freeway. In the 1950s Michigan constructed the state's Interstates such as I-75, the Kalamazoo South Belt, and the M-146 Port Huron bypass, which facilitated faster and less expensive travel for Michiganders.

As a result of the construction of highways and freeways, travel by steamship became passe,

and the SS Western States was tied up in the Detroit River from 1950 to 1955.

As a way to support tourism in Northeast Michigan, the ship's owners and Tawas City officials arranged to move the SS Western States to Tawas Bay in 1955 to become Michigan's first Floating Hotel, or "flotel" and the world's first "flotel."

After its arrival, the flotel, now unofficially renamed the SS Overniter, would be renovated to include a recreation center, small shops, and staterooms. Also, part of the arrangements was an agreement to employ local people during the summer months.

On Sunday evening, June 19, 1955, as reported by the *losco News*, the *SS Overniter* arrived at the Tawas City Dock after its uneventful journey from Detroit via the tug John M. Roehm III.

Upon its arrival at the dock, the ship had to be maneuvered into its narrow berth next to the

In preparation for its arrival, workmen had dredged a channel to bring the boat into the dock. The entrance to the harbor was approximately 15 feet deep and the depth at the dock was 12 feet. In order to accommodate the more than 19-foot depth of the SS Overniter, the entrance to the harbor and depth at the dock was deepened accordingly.

In addition, the Tawas City Park Board had approved enlarging and improving the dock and

improving the Park in preparation for the ship's arrival.

Hundreds of cars filled with curious onlookers lined the streets to view the historic arrival to the Tawases, while a large crowd gathered near the dock to witness the historic event.

Charles Bieber, the ship's owner, reported that reconditioning of the ship would take place after the ship was secured in the harbor. The SS Overniter, he stated, would also include accommodations for conventions and public dining, along with shops.

An Open House took place on June 29, with a huge turnout of visitors from lower Michigan and Ohio. Although still being painted, cleaned, and decorated, a grand opening of the SS Overniter took place the weekend of July 4, 1955. Excitement overflowed for the new floating hotel, but it was short lived.

By the end of July 1955, The Conservation Department of the State of Michigan raised concerns over the legality of the location of the SS Overniter. Thomas M. Kavanaugh, Attorney General, was asked to rule on the question as to whether or not the flotel could legally operate at its current location at the Tawas City Dock. According to Kavanaugh, "the dock is owned by Tawas



City, but the bottom of the Great Lakes is held in trust for all the people. The question now arises does the use of the dock by the SS Overniter as a flotel constitute a trespass? It seems to some that such use is similar to abutting property owners filling in to expand their property along the Great Lakes."

A ruling was needed because the law was clear on navigable vessels, but the flotel does not come under that classification. Before taking any action on the issue, the Conservation Department would review the lease between the

City of Tawas City and the owners of the SS Overniter.

At the same time rumors and questions arose concerning the handling of sewage of the SS Overniter. According to the Michigan State Department of Health, the sewage was being held in closed tanks and being transferred to the local sewage plant by a septic tank service truck and plans were in place to install a sewer at the Tawas City Park where the SS Overniter would tie into the system as soon as the installation is complete. The Michigan State Health Department approved the plans for handling the sewage of the SS Overniter.

Although not "officially" ordered to stop work on the pier, city officials received an "informal" order from the state saying to stop work because such work was illegal even though the city had a

permit from the Army Corps of Engineers.

The delays in opening for business caused financial hardship for the owners, resulting in a sale of the SS Overniter in July 1956 to a Detroit corporation.

The new owners decided to return the ship's name to its former status as the SS Western States and to completely renovate and remodel the ship into a modern resort. With a crew of more than 20 workers, the owners planned to be open for business by the end of summer 1956.

During the summer of 1956, more than \$100,000 was spent to recondition the ship and enlarge staterooms. The sprinkler system was rebuilt to add additional fire protection equipment. Connections were made to the ship to add water and sewer lines to the Tawas City water and sewer systems. The remodeling made improvements needed to operate the ship as a hotel and convention center.

On Nov. 1, 1956, the *losco County News* reported the *SS Western States* would open on Friday, Nov. 9. The event started off with a cocktail party and dinner for representatives of newspaper, radio, televising, and travel agencies. The *SS Western States* would be open seven days a week all year long. The dining room on the ship would serve breakfast, lunch, and dinner. Square Dance night was scheduled for every Wednesday night, and a live band would play for Thursday, Friday, and Saturday nights.

Sherman Rosen, the ship's owner announced that the misunderstanding with the Michigan Conservation Commission would be cleared up, and stated, "We definitely are not fixed to the bottom, and I know that everything will come out right for everyone."

An inspection made by Chief Boatswains Mate, Robert Peters, of the Tawas Coast Guard reported that the SS Western States, "appeared to be free fore and aft." However, Peters added,

"only a diver could definitely determine whether the craft was solidly aground or not."

However, the excitement was short lived. On Nov. 22, 1956, the *losco County News* reported that Kavanaugh asked for an injunction to prevent the owners of the *SS Western States* from continuing to occupy their location at the Tawas City Dock. Judge Louis Coash set Jan. 3, 1957, as the date for a hearing on the matter.

Tawas City Mayor at the time, George Myles, stated that he had not been served with a court order on the matter



and that he was convinced that "outside influences" were involved. Myles continued, "We (The City Council) have done everything that we could do. The *Western States* has water and sewer connections. It has complied with the fire marshall's requirements. Why can't they let us alone?"

Nicholas Olds, assistant attorney general stated that city officials would be served with a court

order sometime later in the week.

In early December of 1956, Attorney General Kavanaugh expressed his opinion that discretionary power in regard to new projects affecting submerged lands was the answer to remedying the issue with the *SS Western States*. Kavanaugh stated that Michigan's 1955 "submerged lands" law was ineffective in dealing with the problem. The cut-off date for encroachments was established as of Oct. 14, 1955. According to Mayor George Myles, the *SS Western States* was in Tawas City and hooked up to city water prior to the Oct. 14, 1955, cut-off date.

Rosen, owner of the SS Western States, stated that his attorneys were preparing to ask for a

dismissal of the state's action against him at the hearing scheduled on Jan. 3,1957.

Judge Coash ruled that the SS Western States could remain open and operate pending a trial to determine the legal status of its operation. Coash refused the request of the conservation department for an injunction to close down the SS Western States. Coash also ordered a \$10,000 bond be posted by the owners of the SS Western States as a guarantee in case the final outcome required removal of the ship.

At the time of the hearing, the owners of the SS Western States complained that the state should have taken action against them before they spent \$100,000 on refurbishing the ship as a

hotel and conference center.

In September 1957, a separate issue involving a company in Tawas City who was proposing a dock, Nicholas Olds, Kavanaugh's Assistant Attorney General, cited laws governing submerged lands to English common law as well as Michigan's decisions in 1843 and 1869. According to Olds, "Under common law of England, the riparian owner on water whose banks were owned by the crown had the right of access but no more...that this doctrine is squarely in line with the decisions made by the Michigan Supreme Court during the early history of our state.

"Thus, we are compelled to take the position based upon the common law of Michigan that although the riparian owner in one of our Great Lakes has certain rights of access to the waters fronting his uplands, nevertheless, since he is not the owner and has not title to the bed of the lake, he cannot erect any structures out over the beds of the Great Lakes without the consent and

approval of the state granted him through express legislative enactment."

The SS Western States closed operations temporarily after Labor Day 1957.

In October 1957, a rumor circulated stating that the *SS Western States* had been sold for scrap. The ship's owners stated that the ship was closed temporarily while the City of Tawas City is working to secure title to the lake bottom under the boat to clarify the situation with the Conservation Department. The owners were also seeking to secure a resort license and stated that as soon as the current problems were resolved, they planned to reopen the ship for business. The owners denied that the ship had been sold or that it was being scrapped.

In April 1958, Rosen, owner of the *SS Western States*, reported that the ship was for sale for \$75,000, stating his health as the reason for giving up on the luxurious flotel. Rosen estimated the ship's value at \$500,000, which included more than \$150,000 in converting the ship to a flotel.

Rosen was selling the ship in spite of the fact that the flotel had a five-year lease with the City of Tawas City and water and sewer connections to city utilities, plus another option for a five-year lease.

Rosen and the city had fought the state in the courts but ultimately it was decided that the ship illegally occupied submerged lands by the state. Another element that strengthened the state's position is that the water level of Lake Huron had dropped three feet which meant that the hull was deeply embedded in the clay bottom at the dock.

Rosen stated that he would take his losses and get out. He had a heart attack the previous

November and didn't have the health to continue to operate the flotel.

At the end of November 1958, the *SS Western States* was sold to the Bay City Scrap Co. for \$30,000. All movable furniture and supplies would be moved prior to partially dismantling it at its current location in Tawas City. The hull will be towed to Bay City for final scrapping.



"Western States Meets Fiery End" was the headline in the *losco County News* on March 24, 1959. According to the article, "the fire broke out about 5:30 p.m. on Saturday, March 21. Flames shot hundreds of feet into the air and a heavy cloud of smoke hung over the area, attracting thousands to the lakeside. It was still burning at 8:00. By then it had been reduced to the steel hull."

According to the March 24, 1959, article in the *losco County News*, "a Bay City Scrap Co. official stated that a workman had been using a torch to cut off a steel mast when the mast broke loose and dropped on a fuel oil tank, starting a blaze that spread rapidly over the oil-soaked plank decking."

The Tawas City Fire Department arrived to find the fire out of control and had to let the fire burn itself out.

Tawas's residents filled the dock to witness the tragic end of the SS Western States flotel.







Lake Huron is known for some of the best pike fishing. Tawas Bay holds the biggest specimens. Be sure to visit popular fishing spots in the Tawas Area. For Lake Huron, fishing is available off the pier in the East Tawas State Harbor, Tawas City's Shoreline Park pier, or the fishing pier in Tawas City's Gateway Park. Non-motorized watercraft can be launched from both Tawas City Shoreline Park and Tawas City Veterans Park. Other popular fishing spots include the Tawas River, Tawas Point State Park, AuSable River, the Fishing Park on Nunn Road, and Tawas Lake. You can also venture out from the DNR boat launch or Jerry's Marina in East Tawas, or the Gateway Park boat launch in Tawas City.


