

DECLARATION OF DISASTER

WHEREAS, the City of Huntsville, on the 23rd day of May, 2023, has suffered widespread or severe damage, injury, or loss of life or property resulting from:

Severe Weather, Flooding, Damaging Winds, Tornadoic Activity, Downed Trees and  
Multiple days of Power Outages.

WHEREAS, the Mayor of Huntsville has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property, City streets and city facilities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE MAYOR OF CITY OF HUNTSVILLE, TX:

1. That a local state of disaster is hereby declared for the City of Huntsville, TX. pursuant to §418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.
2. Pursuant to §418.108(b) of the Government Code, the state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the City Council of the City of Huntsville, TX.
3. Pursuant to §418.108(c) of the Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the City Secretary.
4. Pursuant to §418.108(d) of the Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster activates the city emergency management plan.
5. That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
