Local Emergency Order

I, Svante Myrick, the Mayor of the City of Ithaca, in accordance with a declaration of a State of
Emergency issued on, 2020, and pursuant to Section 24 of the State Executive Law, hereby
order, notwithstanding local law to the contrary, and until further notice, the establishment of the Rent
Forgiveness Commission for the City of Ithaca (the "Commission"). The Commission shall be comprised
of five members appointed by the Mayor, including a Chair selected by the Mayor, and will include thre
City renters and two City landlords.

The Commission shall be empowered and directed, subject to applicable state and federal law, to institute systems and rules for the forgiveness of rent and the extension of leases for those tenants in the City of Ithaca otherwise in severe jeopardy of homelessness as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic. The Commission shall account for all available sources of rental assistance, including programs recently adopted by the City, when defining "severe jeopardy of homelessness" for purposes of this order. The Commission shall also make recommendations to City government for funding allocations that could reduce or eliminate the need for rent forgiveness.

This order is effective immediately and shall apply until removed by order of the Mayor.
