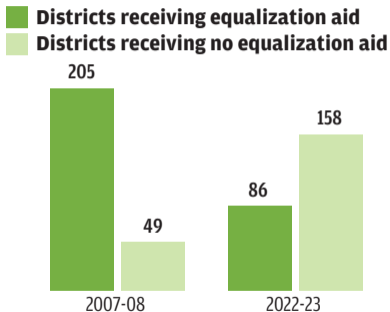


Drop in K-12 districts receiving school aid

Fifteen years ago, more than 80% of Nebraska school districts received equalization aid, the state dollars intended to make sure they have enough combined property and state dollars to meet their needs. But after a big runup in real estate values, particularly for farmland, dozens of districts lost those dollars.
