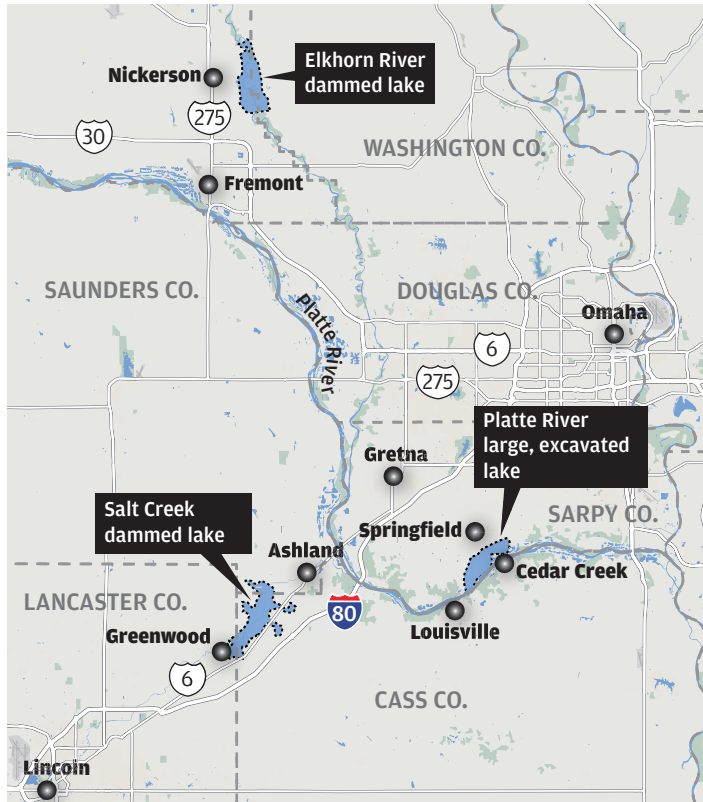


5-column grid

A new study identified three potential sites for a large lake. 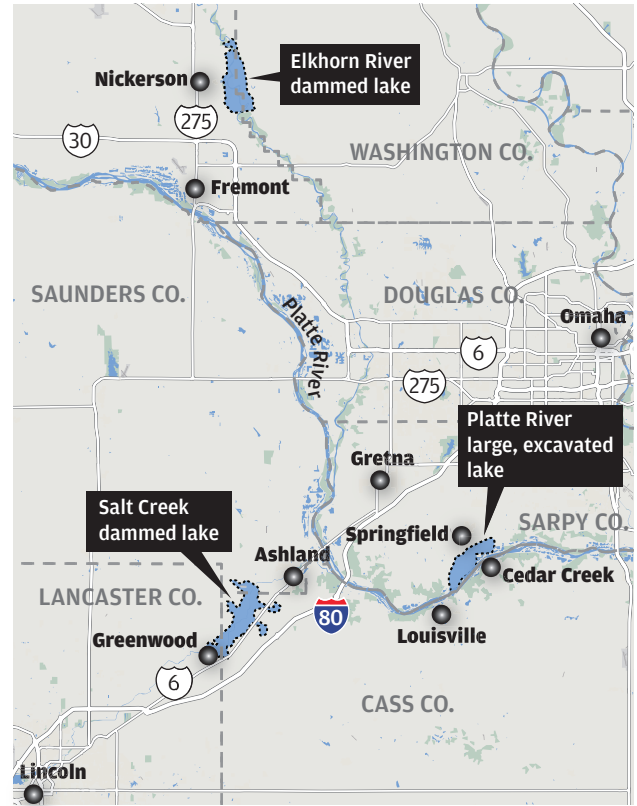
